# 3. Product Description

WOOD IRON INTERIOR TOP COAT is a clear finish for new interior wood surfaces. The Satin leaves a fairly flat finish with a slight sheen. The Semi-Gloss leaves a shinier, reflective sheen. The Top Coat will stay clear and dries quickly so successive coats can be done in one day. It will not yellow like lacquer or varnish and has a urethane component that makes it tough and durable. It is low odor, low V.O.C., non-combustible and non-flammable.

**Basic Use:** It is designed for use interior new wood that is stained or unstained. It can be used on doors, trim, window frames, window seats and wood furniture for interior use.

**Composition and materials:** WOOD IRON INTERIOR TOP COAT FINISH is a water-based acrylic finish with modified urethane.

## 4. Installation

All interior wood to be finished must be free of dirt and other surface contaminants. Do Not assume that new wood is free of contamination. All interior wood to be finished must be free of dirt, marks, fingerprints and other surface contaminants. Do Not assume that new wood is free of contamination. All interior new wood must be cleaned before coating.

## Cleaning/Preparation

- 1. Sand with open coat, non-stearated sand paper 150 grit combined with a random orbital sander or use a medium/fine sanding sponge.
- 2. Sand with the grain.
- 3. Remove dust by duster brush and/or compressed air. Do not use tack clothes.

Note: Wood will develop a "patina" that when sanded through will reveal a lighter color substrate. If sanding is the preparation of choice, be prepared to sand everything to produce an even looking surface.

CAUTION: Do not use steel wool. Particles that might remain on the surface can rust.

# **Application**

Wood must be completely dry and free of blemishes and surface contamination.

Mask all items not receiving finish such as windows, floors, carpet, etc.

**Note:** Check all areas before applying finish. Wood should be free of splinters, dust, oil or any other unevenness or contamination.,

Follow all directions on the label at all times.
